1. INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES:-

a) Candidates who have been allotted through centralized counseling by the MCC of DGHS, New Delhi for admission to **M.B.B.S/B.D.S** Degree courses in the Medical/Dental College for the academic year **2026-27**, are advised to report and complete the admission process strictly within the date and time specified in the '**Allotment Letter**' issued by the MCC of DGHS.

b) Allotment letter given by the MCC of DGHS, New Delhi, for admission shall be subject to fulfillment of all eligibility criteria prescribed by the **NMC/DCI** and also medical fitness of the candidates. Those who do not fulfill the prescribed eligibility criteria and not found medically fit will not be admitted to the course of study to which they are allotted by the MCC of DGHS, which also shall be communicated to MCC.

c) The candidates should bring the following certificates in Original (along with **one set of photocopy of the same without fail):-**

- i. Allotment letter issued by the MCC of DGHS, New Delhi.
- ii. NEET (UG) – 2026 Admit Card issued by NTA (used at the time of Examination).
- iii. NEET (UG) - 2026 Result/Rank letter issued by NTA.
- iv. CBSE / HSC / ISC or Equivalent Mark Statement.
- v. NRI candidates, who have passed the 12th Grade Diploma, should have taken the subjects viz., Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Bio-technology and English.
- vi. Candidates with foreign qualifications must submit equivalency certificate from the University Grants Commissions (UGC), New Delhi.
- vii. Transfer Certificate and Conduct Certificate.
- viii. A Copy of 10th Mark Sheet / Grade statement.
- ix. A Copy of Aadhaar Card.
- x. A Copy of ABC/APAAR ID.
- xi. A Copy of Birth Certificate.
- xii. A Copy of Community Certificate, if applicable.
- xiii. 4 Passport size photographs (same as affixed in NEET Admit Card).
- xiv. Foreign nationals should produce either OCI card or Students Visa without fail at the time of admission.
- xv. **OCI card holders, even if they opt to come under General Category, have to submit their Passport and OCI card copies, along with originals, for the purpose of documentation.**

d) The Sponsored candidates who are allotted under NRI Quota by the MCC of DGHS should produce the following additional documents:-

- i) Documents claiming that the sponsor is a NRI (Passport, Visa of the sponsorer).
- ii) Relationship of NRI with the candidate as per the court orders of The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case W.P.(c) No.689/2017- Consoritum of Deemed Universities in Karnataka (CODEUNIK) & Ans. Vs Union of India & Ors. Dated 22.08.2017.
- iii) Affidavit from the sponsorer that he/she will sponsor the entire course fee of the candidate, duly notarized.
- iv) Embassy Certificate of the Sponsorer (Certificate from the Consulate)

e) Candidates without the original certificates shall not be allowed to take admission in the allotted Medical/Dental College. Candidates who have deposited their original documents with any other Institute/ College/University or come for admission with a certificate stating that "their original certificates are deposited with the Institute/ College/University" shall not be allowed to take admission in the allotted Medical/Dental College.

8. COURSE DISCONTINUE POLICY:-

a) Amount of Fee to be deducted from the candidate in case of withdrawal/resignation as per MCC of DGHS notification.	For MBBS: Rs.30,000/- (Rupees thirty thousand only). For BDS: Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only).
b) In case not covered under condition in column 8 (a) above , the amount of fee payable (where the seat is rendered vacant without having any chance of being filled up with any other candidates)	As per University norms
c) Time for Refund of amount, if any.	Within 21 days.

9. HOSTEL FACILITY:-

- a) Rooms of various categories with required facilities will be allotted to the students who wish to stay in the Hostel. However, request for allotment of Hostel Room with specific facility will be subject to availability of the same.
- b) Within 7 days after the last day of the academic year, the hostler should vacate the room compulsorily in order to facilitate annual maintenance work.
- c) When the hostler reports at the start of next academic sessions, room earmarked for the 'specific batch of students' in a Block/floor only, will be allotted by the Chief Warden. No student will be allowed to stay in a particular room continuously for entire duration of course.

10. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:-

- a) If a candidate fails to report on the date and time specified by the MCC of DGHS in the allotment order or produce the original Certificates/Documents and/or fails to pay the tuition fee by Demand Draft/Electronic Fund Transfer through RTGS and furnish UTR No. (For NRI Students through Wire Transfer) on the day of admission, he/she will not be permitted to proceed with the admission process. The vacancy arising therefrom will be duly notified to the MCC of DGHS for further action as per rules.
- b) Students will be governed by all the University rules including rules for refund of fee, disciplinary rules, hostel rules and UGC/NMC/DCI Regulations for Curbing the Menace of Ragging etc., as given in the Student Manual of SRIHER (DU). - c) At the time of admission, candidates should sign a declaration/under taking declaring that they shall abide by the rules and regulation of the University including Anti-Ragging Regulations of the UGC/NMC/DCI and observe good conduct and behavior and that they are bound by the University Rules on payment of fees/refund of fees.

11. IMPORTANT NOTE:-

- a) All disputes arising in the interpretation and implementation of the provisions in this Prospectus will be referred to the Vice-Chancellor of this Deemed to be University and the Vice-Chancellor's decision shall be final and binding.
- b) In respect of matters relating to or arising out of this prospectus the jurisdiction shall lie in Chennai alone.
